

Meeting March 9, 2009

Members present Harold Kauffman Stanley (Pete) Worrall and Don Whitesel. Marian Casner and Andy Winder were also present.

Grant Kanish from Guardian Inspection Service was present to present a proposal to the supervisors to have the township transfer the inspecting services from their current service Commonwealth Code to Guardian. The supervisors stated they would take it into consideration. We currently have a contract with Commonwealth Code but will have our attorney look at the contract and decide what they want to do.

Mr. John Bachman and Mr. Brady Long who own property along Washington Ave. in Mifflintown ask what if anything could be done about the sewage problem at their properties. They stated they are constantly having sewer problems. The supervisors stated that the problem will be addressed one way or the other, either by the township or if the lines are turned over to twin boroughs they will address the problem.

Ms. Becky Leiter and Tom Leiter were here to give the financial report for the year 2009 from the Mifflintown Fire Company.

A motion to approve the 2009 contract with the fire company was made by Harold Kauffman second by Pete Worrall with unanimous approval by Don Whitesel.

Mr. John Bishop was here to ask about the status of the sewage plant that Mr. John Groninger has built at his development near the Archrock Interchange. The supervisors stated that they are currently in the process of updating the 537 plan for the township and are having our engineer check out the feasibility of that or a similar plant in the future to take care of sewage problems in the township. It is in no way a done deal that we will connect to that plant or any plant in the near future.

Marian informed the supervisors that the Juniata Meals on Wheels to ask if the township could make a donation had contacted the township. A motion to donate one thousand dollars to the program was made by Don Whitesel second by Pete Worrall with unanimous approval by Harold Kauffman.

Marian informed the supervisors that there was a request had been made by Keith Mingle to meet and finalize the road-naming project for the township. The meeting was set for Friday March 13, 2009 at 8:00am. in the township office.

A motion to pay the bills for March was made by Harold Kauffman second by Pete Worrall with unanimous approval by Don Whitesel.
