

Monthly Meeting November 13, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 7:30pm. Members present were Harold Kauffman Don Whitesel and Pete Worrall. Marian Casner and Andrew Winder were also present.

1. Charles Schlegel was here to ask about setbacks to build a garage on his property on Airport Drive within the township. He was told that he would need to be 12 feet from the property line. He also wants the roadmaster to check a hole at the end of his driveway.

2. A motion to accept the articles of agreement with Juniata Sewage Office was made by Pete Worrall second Harold Kauffman with unanimous approval by Don Whitesel.

3. Mr. Winder was ask if he was able to determine if a house could be built on a lot at the intersection of Quigley Lane And Juniata View Drive. He stated that in his calculations they will be allowed to build but we will have our engineer review the Airport Zoning Ordinance.

4. A letter from Penn dot was presented to the board stating that they would like a plan to pave parts of 322 be placed on the agenda for the next meeting.

5. An application to put our Liquid Fuel money into an account with PLIGIT was made4 by Harold Kauffman second by Pete Worrall with unanimous approval by Don Whitesel the move was made because of a better interest rate then we can get at the local bank. A motion to remove any outdated names from the existing accounts was also made by Don Whitesel second by Harold Kauffman with approval by Pete Worrall.

6. A copy of a letter from Ms. Stacey Nace was presented to the supervisors she would like a speed limit sign which she states is in her yard to be moved. The roadmaster will look at the sign however he believes that the sign is on the township right of way and only needs to be raised up about four feet higher then it is now.

7. A letter from Tom Metz to get an extension on the plans for St, Judes was presented to the supervisors. A motion to grant the extension was made by Don Whitesel second by Pete Worrall with approval by Harold Kauffman.

8. A motion to pay the bills for November was made by Pete Worrall second Don Whitesel with approval by Harold Kauffman.

9. Pete Worrall told the board that Mr. Keith Mingle would be in on Wednesday to finish naming township roads.

10. Maureen Jordan thanked the supervisors for allowing her to attend a convention for the Planning Commission. She stated that it was very educational.

11. The tentative budget for 2008 was presented to the board. A motion to advertise the budget, which will be adopted at the next meeting, was made by Harold Kauffman second Don Whitesel with approval by Pete Worrall. The tentative budget is 414486.15 dollars with 192017.70 unappreciated funds.

12. Ms. Sheila Yorks posed a question as to who is to be responsible for the old canal house restoration.

13. The meeting then went to executive session to discuss the findings of the District Justice on a civil suit brought by Jay Fulkroad and Sons Inc. against the township because we withheld six thousand six hundred dollars from our payment for work done on Stoner Road in 2006. A motion to accept the decision was made by Harold Kauffman second by Don Whitesel with approval by Pete Worrall.

14. Mr. Winder stated that he had spoken with Mr. Rich Royer about pumping the holding tanks at the Jerome McNemara property and he stated that he had within the last month but can produce no receipts. Mr. Winder stated that the township could impose a civil penalty on Mr. McNemara because he has nit proven he had the tank pumped. A motion to impose the minimum penalty was made by Harold Kauffman second by Pete Worrall with approval by Don Whitesel.
